As required by North Carolina General Statute and Moore County Schools Board Policy, each School Improvement Team has collaborated on the creation of a school improvement plan for the next two academic school years. - The goal is to determine effective instructional practices and methods to ensure schools are growing students and increasing proficiency in all subgroups through actionable steps that are consistently measured, assessed, and modified if needed.
- The result is a living school improvement plan focused on student achievement and aligned to the MCS District Strategic Plan.

Moore County Schools welcomes all stakeholders into the continuous improvement process by allowing "view-only" capability and "real-time" transparency of the school improvement plan process to all staff, district personnel, school board members, and parents.
